Just got these figures and information today.

Floors Direct is still holding the tile for the library floor (paid for) however we will pay for the installation of the tile. (under\$1,000.00).

We will be getting a credit for the base board as we will be installing wood, the areas have 0 traffic so there's no concern for wear and tear. I am requesting a \$5,000.00 budget to complete the wains coating, chair rails, 6 pieces of molding to go around the 2 existing doors, paint for the existing book shelves, insulation and acoustic tiles to finish off the ceiling, wood for the molding for the windows, wood for the base board plus misc., liquids nails, screws, drywall mud etc.

All the labor so far has been in house, saving the community thousands and thousands of dollars!!

More funding may be required for the countertop, windowsills, window treatments, and possible door replacement.

I will have pricing for these remaining items to present to the Trustees at the next board meeting. We will again be doing most of the labor in house, thanks so much to Bob Shearer and Roger Frenette!!!!
