The wainscoting, trim, door casings, ceiling tiles and brackets for the countertop have been installed in the library. The bookshelves are being built, primed and painted. The installation of the bookshelves will begin the last week of December as well as the countertop.

I will be working closely with HPPOA to discuss furnishings and window treatments.

The gazebo engineering plans are still in progress (3 to 5 weeks) lead time then construction will be approximately (3 to 4 weeks). I am in constant contact with Amish Country Gazebo and will keep the Trustees updated.
