PHASE ONE

- 1. WASH HANDS WITH SOAP AND WATER FOR AT LEAST 20 SECONDS. IF SOAP OR ANTISEPTIC ARE NOT AVAILABLE, MAKE YOUR OWN (2/3 CUP RUBBING ALCOHOL, 90% ALCOHOL, 1/3 CUP ALOE VERA GEL) OPTIONAL (ONE DROP OF ESSENTIAL OIL).**
- 2. COVER COUGHS AND SNEEZES WITH A TISSUE OR USE INSIDE ELBOW**
- 3. CLEAN FREQUENTLY TOUCHED OBJECTS AT HOME OR OUT IN PUBLIC**
- 4. STAY HOME WHEN SICK**
- 5. PROVIDE VIRUS SUPPLIES AT OUR OFFICE, I.E., SOAP, HAND SANITIZER, TISSUES, TRASH BASKETS, DISPOSABLE MASKS IN CASE SOMEONE GETS SICK (ASSUMING WE CAN GET THESE ITEMS)**
- 6. STAY INFORMED ABOUT LOCAL VIRUS INFORMATION AND UPDATES. SEE "BREVARD COUNTY HEALTH" SEE ADDITIONAL CONTACTS AT END OF HEALTH PLAN.**
- 7. DURING AN EVENT, IF SOMEONE GETS SICK, GET THEM TO AN ISOLATED ROOM AND ASK THEM TO LEAVE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.**
- 8. SPEAK OUT AGAINST NEGATIVE BEHAVIOR TO HELP COUNTER DISCRIMINATION.**

PHASE TWO: VIRUS IS IN AREA, BUT NOT IN OUR PARK

- 1. TESTING MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME. IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS, STAY HOME, CALL YOUR DOCTOR OR BREVARD COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT. YOU WILL BE TOLD WHERE TO GO FOR TESTING WHEN AVAILABLE.**
- 2. IF YOU DECIDE TO QUARANTINE YOURSELF AT THIS TIME WITH NO SYMPTOMS, KEEP IN MIND, YOU MAY STILL GET THE VIRUS WHEN YOU COME OUTSIDE.**
- 3. DO NOT GO ON A CRUISE!**
- 4. IF YOU NEED TO FLY, BE AWARE OF SPACING (6 FEET)**
- 5. BE AWARE OF TOUCHING SURFACES THAT MAY BE CONTAMINATED AND AS ALWAYS, CARRY HAND SANITIZER WITH YOU.**

PHASE THREE: CONTAMINATION IS IN THE PARK

1. ALL PUBLIC FUNCTIONS CANCELLED
2. EVERYONE IS ASKED TO STAY HOME AND QUARANTINE THEMSELVES
3. REMEMBER, THIS HAS BEEN DECLARED A NATIONAL EMERGENCY AND A PANDEMIC, THEREFORE YOU MUST TAKE THIS SERIOUSLY
4. THE OFFICE WILL BE CLOSED WITH THE ATTEMPT TO ALLOW OFFICE EMPLOYEES TO WORK AT HOME AND ACCESS OFFICE COMPUTERS
5. POOLS WILL BE CLOSED
6. ENTIRE PARK WILL BE ON QUARANTINE
7. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED INTO PARK EXCEPT CAREGIVERS AND EMERGENCY VEHICLES. THEY MUST BE REGISTERED AT OFFICE FOR ADMISSION
8. "ALL CLEAR" WILL BE ANNOUNCED AND PARK OPEN AT FRONT GATE WHEN THERE IS NO INDICATION OF ACTIVE VIRUS

THERE ARE NO SECURITY PERSONNEL AND NO POLICE ON SITE, SO WE CANNOT MAKE ANY RESIDENT ABIDE BY POLICY
